39 ARTICLES: COMMENTARY & REFLECTIONS

Article XIV. Of Works of Supererogation.

Voluntary Works besides, over and above, God's Commandments, which they call Works of Supererogation. cannot be taught without arrogancy and impiety: for by them men do declare, that they do not only render unto God as much as they are bound to do, but that they do more for his sake, than of bounden duty is required: whereas Christ saith plainly When ye have done all that are commanded to you, say, We are unprofitable servants.

Today we will cover the final article in a sub-section we might call "the place of good works." Since the foundational statement in Article XI on the Justification of Man, we have seen answers to all potential questions when accepting justification by faith alone: The place and quality of good works, the value of works done before justification, and now the value of works after justification.

If works after Justification do have value, how much value do they have? Can the extra good works be stored up for another time or for other people? This article takes aim at the concept of a Treasury of Merit where Christ, the Virgin Mary, and all the saints store up merit to be dispensed by the Church and its sacraments. The practice of indulgences in the 16th century flowed from this understanding; one could pay the Church to apply superogated merit to assuage the punishments of purgatory for a loved one. This situation is utterly unlike the understanding of merit in the New Testament.

The problem which the Article has with works of supererogation is the "super" part. How can any good work we do be over and above what God commands? How can we do more than the first great commandment, 'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind," or the one like unto it, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself?" God requires of us the bounden duty of our entire lives (Rom. 12:1). To assume works of supererogation is to assume that we can attain God's requirements and have some goodness left over! Instead, the disposition of the servant of God says, "we are unworthy servants. We have only done our duty." (Lk. 17:10).

We see at the end of this sub-section (Articles IX-XIV) that being made right with God must be entirely of grace. Grace before, grace behind, inside and out. The labor of good works in the Lord has great importance, but never for our justification. Grace is utterly gratuitous; it cannot be bought by us and it cannot be lost by us. This is the work the Son has done to set us free (John 8:36).




