Youth Minister Job Description

The Youth ministry of Trinity Episcopal Church is an engaging and welcoming community for its children, youth, young adults and their friends that;

- Models a personal and consistent pursuit of the Lord for the youth to emulate,
- Surrounds youth with an unconditional love that fosters genuine relationships,
- Anchors them in the joys and traditions of the Christian faith,
- Energizes and equips them to extend the love of Christ to the world,
- Cultivate in the youth a foundation for Christian discipleship

The Youth Minister is a full time minister of the Church; as such personal conduct both on and off the church campus is to reflect the highest moral standards. The Youth Minister will exhibit a committed Christian life as reflected in regular worship with the parish community, a dedicated prayer life, and the expectation of continuing the education process to support his/her ministry by attending Rector-led training and other youth and young adult conferences as may be needed.

The Youth minister will supervise a program of regular meetings, events, retreats and mission trips for students 6th – 12th grade. Recruit and train an adult volunteer staff. Develop youth and young adult leadership potential. Coordinate with Rector on long range planning. Manage an annual budget. Specifically, the Youth minister will be responsible for the following:

1. Develop youth Christian formation and programs for students 6th – 12th grade.
2. Facilitate and lead youth meetings (Sunday school and Wednesday nights) with a focus on areas of Christian discipleship: scripture, worship, prayer, evangelism, etc.
3. Recruit and train volunteers from the parish and community to work with youth and young adult groups. Equip adult leadership to serve in youth ministry programs in support and teaching roles
4. Involve the students in parish-wide programs/activities that will spiritually enrich the individuals and the parish.
5. Serve as counselor/mentor to students with a focus on modeling Christian behavior and guiding youth through formidable periods of development
6. Engage with parents in the community in order to attract new students and facilitate a deeper relationship with their children.
7. Serve as religion teacher for 6th – 8th grades for Trinity Episcopal School.
8. Assist the Rector in chaplain duties at Trinity Episcopal School.
9. Plan annual budget for support of youth programs in coordination with Trinity budget committee.
10. Support ecumenical youth/young adult programs that assist in the spiritual development of the parish youth.
11. Become a “Safeguarding God’s Children” trainer.
12. Submit a quarterly written report to the vestry.
